

Getting There

- By Air: Domestic flights from Dhaka to Cox's Bazar cost around \$50–\$80 one way.
- By Bus: Comfortable AC coaches from Dhaka are available for \$15–\$20 one way.
- By Train: Direct train services to Cox's Bazar are expected to begin soon but are currently unavailable.

Local Transport

- Rickshaws and tuk-tuks are affordable for short distances.
- Rental cars and bicycles are available for exploring at your own pace.

Ferry

• Ships/Boat/Ferries are available to Maheshkhali and Saint Martin's Island for affordable rates.

Costs

- Budget: \$15-\$30 per night
- Mid-range: \$30–\$70 per night
- Luxury: \$70–\$300 per night
- Food: Daily \$10-\$20 per person
- Attractions: Entry fees and activities: \$5– \$20 per activity
- Transportation: Local rides (tuk-tuks, autorickshaws): \$2–\$5 per trip and Car rental: \$30–\$50 per day
